



Sailing By: 11 The Digey, St Ives. Cornwall TR26 1HR. Mobile Tel: 07904 596055

Change-over / arrival day is Saturday. We shall meet you at the cottage **at 3pm** and show you round and hand over the key. Please let us have your mobile number so we can keep in touch on the day. If you are coming by car, you will arrive in St Ives on the A3074, having turned off the A30 at Lelant, driving through Carbis Bay you will pass Tesco and Tregenna Castle. As you descend into town you need to take the right hand turn near the Porthminster Hotel towards the train and bus stations (ie keep heading down to the sea / harbour).

Follow the blue arrows → on the map to get to the cottage. Go past the P.O. Queens pub, The Lion pub, cross over Fore St and descend into the harbour where the Lifeboat station is. Follow the quay rd to the Sloop pub and turn left up the hill, take next left to back rd, and left until you see Bumbles tea rooms where you turn sharp left into the Digey. The Digey is narrow and cobbled and but can take a large car. You can stop outside Sailing By to unload; if another car pulls up behind don't panic! It's quite normal to hold up the traffic to unload at changeover time. We all have to be patient. Once unloaded, move the car to one of the car parks. The Island and Barnoon are the nearest large long stay car parks and are 5 mins walk away. A 7-day ticket is £33 (you need a bag of coins!!) and allows you to come and go and use the other long stay parks (handy at busy times). There are plenty of other car parks but you will have to pay for daytime / evening separately and can be quite expensive. Other long stay car parks are the Station and the Coach park. Also there is the big 1000 spaces park at the top of town at the Sports Centre / Swimming Pool with local shuttle bus down to town. Check out is **10am** the following Saturday, if you need to leave earlier then a call out charge of £10 will be payable.
